How do I update the CNAME Records?

A CNAME Record points a domain or subdomain to another domain or subdomain. It tells the DNS server that the page you redirect to is the canonical version of the site. To create a CNAME Record on your domain name you will need to update the DNS Settings. This option is located under each domain within your Account Manager.

For Goshly:

Host - 'www', Points to - '[yoursubdomainname].goshly.com'

- 1. Click on My Account at the top of this page.
- 2. Ensure that **Account Manager** is selected.
- 3. Enter your username and password and click Log In.

- 8. Enter the **Sub Domain** if necessary, followed by the forward CNAME Record **domain or subdomain** in the **Alias For** field.
- 9. Click Update.

Note: CNAME records must point only at a domain name, not at an IP address.

You should avoid pointing one domain with a CNAME record at another domain name with a CNAME record, as this is inefficient. Instead you should point both domains at the same A record.

You should not point an MX record at a CNAME alias. CNAME aliases should not have other DNS records. The only exceptions to this are certain DNSSEC records.

CNAME Records are applied immediately but may take up to 2 hours to propagate across the Internet. If you have created your CNAME Records and have seen no change, please wait for this propagation. Otherwise, it is advised that you contact us.

An A Record (Address Record) points a domain or subdomain to an IP address.

To create an A Record on your domain name you will need to change the **DNS Settings**, which can be found under each domain name within your **Account Manager**.
